Season & Punch Passes are not refundable. \$50 fee prior to start of ski season for Pass transfer. \$25 fee for replacement of lost pass. Swiss Valley CAN NOT replace a Big Ten Pass or 6 Pack. Season Passes are for personal use only and can not be shared. Reselling, exchanging, or lending of either lift ticket or Passes will result in loss of membership without refund. Your Season Pass must be presented for a lift ticket each time you visit. In the absence of your Pass, we reserve the right to charge a \$5 acquisition fee and/or charge the current lift ticket rate.

REFUND POLICY: All Passes purchased are non-refundable. If Swiss Valley is unable to open at all due to COVID - 19, or any other reason, all pass monies paid will be applied to the 2022/2023 Ski Season. However, once we open and start operating, we will not be giving refunds in the event of a government mandated shut down, or any other reason. We are taking the risk and bearing the considerable expense of getting open and making the snow up front to prepare for the season. We understand that in order to take advantage of our best pricing options, you will also be taking the risk of purchasing a Season Pass or Punch Card in advance. If you are uncomfortable with this, we recommend waiting and purchasing daily lift tickets.
